ABOUT US

Sri K. Ramachandran Naidu Telugu Minorities Educational and Charitable Trust was established by late Sri K. Vivekanandan son of Sri K.Ramachandran Naidu has taken charge of the trust in the year 1998 and started Sri K.Ramachandran Naidu College of Nursing in the lieu of providing standard nursing education and to prepare nurses with the highest level of education and practice.

The College is located in Paruvakudi village, K. R. Naidu Nagar, Karivalamvandhanallur Via, Sankarankovil Taluk, Tirunelveli District. The College is situated in 30 acres of land which is midway between Rajapalayam and Sankarankovil. It is about 15 km away from Rajapalayam Town and 10 km away from the Sankarankovil. Since it is highway road, frequent transportation is available to the institution from various districts; The college has its own bus stop in front of the college campus. The nearest railway station is at Rajapalayam Town. The college is surrounded with natural scenario which is peaceful, eco friendly environment and conducive for learning process.

Objectives of the Course

On completion of M.Sc (Nursing) programme the student will;

- 1. Update the current knowledge in nursing subjects and other allied subjects for all round development.
- 2. Apply decision making skills, critical thinking skills, and administrative skills in practice.
- 3. Demonstrate teaching skills by incorporating all principles and methods of teaching with necessary A.V.Aids.
- 4. Develop as a nurse researcher by applying steps in research process and excel in conduction of research projects.
- 5. Acquire sound knowledge in clinical specialized area in order to render comprehensive health care.

Eligibility

- 1. The minimum educational requirements shall be the passing of: B.Sc Nursing / Post Basic B.Sc Nursing with minimum of 55% aggregate marks.
- 2. The candidate should be a registered nurse and registered midwife or equivalent in any state nursing council (Tamilnadu nurses and midwives council registration is must).
- 3. The candidate should have undergone B.Sc Nursing / Post Basic B.Sc Nursing in an institution which is recognized by Indian Nursing Council.
- 4. Minimum one year of work experience after Basic B.Sc Nursing.
- 5. Minimum of one year of work experience prior or after Post Basic B.Sc Nursing.
- 6. Candidate should be medically fit.
- 7. In case of male candidates they should have passed any other course recommended by the Indian Nursing Council in lieu of midwifery.
- * Subjected to change as per revisions of norms by University and Council.

The 150 bedded Sri K. Ramachandran Naidu Memorial Hospital is also accommodated with in the college campus and the college also has collaborative tie-up arrangements with private super specialty hospitals, Government Hospital and Primary Health Centre which has wide and varied specialty areas with modern technological advances in order to provide opportunities for optimal development of clinical skills for the students.

2. BASIC B.Sc (NURSING) - 4YEARS

Objectives of the Course

On completion of Basic B.Sc (Nursing) Programme the student will;

- 1. Acquire sound knowledge of theory and practice of nursing and allied subjects in order to render comprehensive nursing care.
- 2. Apply nursing process to assess, diagnose, plan, implement and evaluate patient care.
- 3. Approach the patient with positive attitude, service mindedness and establish good interpersonal relationship.
- Demonstrate professional skills in providing service to patient and act as student teacher in educating the students.
- Participate as health team member in Promotive, Restorative, Preventive and Rehabilitative Health Services of the country in accordance with National Health Programmes and International Health Policies.
- 6. Develop as Nurse Practitioner, Nurse Educator, Nurse Administrator, Nurse Researcher and Nurse Leader.
- 7. Recognize the need for continued learning in order to develop them personally and professionally.
- 8. Practice ethical values of nursing profession in both personal and professional life.
- 9. Keep the standards of nursing profession by all means and work hard for the upliftment of the profession.

Eligibility

- 1. A candidate should have completed the age of 17 years at the time of admission or would complete the said age on or before 31st December of the year of admission to the first year nursing course.
- 2. Candidate should have passed +2 examination. The subjects and marks in +2 examination is as per Indian Nursing Council and The Tamilnadu Dr. M.G.R. Medical University norms.
- 3. Only female candidates are admitted to the course.
- 4. The candidate should be medically fit.
- * Subjected to change as per revisions of norms by University and Council.

(3) POST BASIC B.Sc (NURSING) - 2 YEARS

Objectives of the Course

On completion of Post Basic B.Sc (Nursing) programme the student will;

- 1. Take care of their patients independently with responsibility.
- 2. Utilize the knowledge of different science subjects in their field of clinical practice.
- 3. Apply their professional skills to the patient care of all ages admitted with different problems along with other health team members.
- 4. Be aware of sociological, biological sciences and different psychological influences on the behaviour of a person.
- 5. Demonstrate the ability to teach and take care of the family and community.

- 6. Develop and demonstrate the basic skills of patient management and apply them as fit to their area of service.
- 7. Render quality care and evaluate their own performance.
- 8. Understand and uphold the dignity of the profession.

Eligibility

- 1. Candidate should have qualified in Diploma in General Nursing and Midwifery and be a Registered Nurse and Midwife in the Tamilnadu Nurses and Midwives Council or any other State Nursing Council accepted by the authority of this University (Registration in Tamilnadu Nurses and Midwives Council is must).
- 2. Candidate should have minimum of one year experience in any teaching Institution/Hospital or as a whole time Public Health Nurse with registration in State Nursing Council.
- 3. If the registration certificate cannot be obtained immediately, the original evidence for registration in the form of receipt or any other authenticated document from the office of the State Nursing Council will be accepted in lieu of the Registration Certificate.
- 4. A male nurse candidate registered with State Nursing Council shall produce evidence of having been trained in any of the subject approved by the Indian Nursing Council for duration of last 6 months in lieu of midwifery.
 - 5. Candidate should be medically fit.
- * Subjected to change as per revisions of norms by University and Council.

(4) DIPLOMA IN GENERAL NURSING AND MIDWIFERY - 3 YEARS

Objectives of the course

On Completion of Diploma in General Nursing and Midwifery programme the student will;

- 1. Demonstrate competency in providing health care to individual, sick or well, using nursing process.
- Apply knowledge from the humanities, biological and behavioural sciences in functioning as a nurse.
- Function effectively with members of the health team and community applying the knowledge of human relations and communication skills in her work.
- 4. Demonstrate use of ethical values in their personal and professional life.
- 5. Recognize the need for continuing education for their personal and professional development.

Eligibility

- 1. The candidate should have completed 17 years of age.
- 2. Candidate should have passed +2 examination with an aggregate of 40% of marks.
- 3. 5% of relaxation marks for SC/ST candidates may be given.
- 4. Candidate should be medically fit.
- 5. Only female candidates are admitted.
- * Subjected to change as per revisions of norms by Indian Nursing Council and State Nursing Council.

The candidate admission is confirmed only after the registration of the candidate is certified by The Tamilnadu Dr. M.G.R. Medical University by remitting the prescribed fees.

Library

Faculty

The college of nursing has dynamic, dedicated, qualified and experienced faculty members. The institution provides the avenue for a good student - faculty interaction which fosters a healthy, stimulating environment for growth of the students.

Sports and recreation

The college provides sports facilities for the indoor and out door games under the supervision of qualified physical training teachers. The college has a large play ground for athletic events. A spacious Recreational hall equipped with the Television with cable connection, DVD Player, CD, Tape recorder, etc.

Clinical Facilities

The students clinical experiences are planned according to their year of placement in B.Sc (N), Post Basic B.Sc (N), M.Sc (N) and Diploma in General Nursing & Midwifery courses and in accordance with subject exposure. The high co relation of theory and practice is incorporated and students are posted in various multi speciality hospitals for gaining the richest clinical experience.

ATTENDENCE REQUIRED FOR ADMISSION TO EXAMINATION

- 1. No candidate shall be permitted to write examination for all the courses with out completing the prescribed theory and practical hours.
- 2. Candidate should have 100% of attendance in each of Theory and practical / clinical areas before award of degree.

EXAMINATION AND RESULTS

- 1. The examinations will be scheduled as per the regulations of The Tamilnadu Dr. M.G.R. Medical University, Chennai for all the courses except Diploma in General Nursing and Midwifery.
- 2. The examinations for Diploma in General Nursing and Midwifery programme will be scheduled as per the regulations of Board of Examination for Nurses, Director of Medical Education, Chennai.
- 3. A candidate has to pass in theory and practical examination separately.









Dissertation for M.Sc Nursing Programme

The evaluation of dissertation for the M.Sc Nursing course should be done by the examiner prior to the viva. The duration for viva voce examination is 30 minutes.

The guidelines for tentative schedule of dissertation are as follows;

- The research proposal should be submitted at the end of the 9th month of the 1st year.
- The submission of final dissertation copies should be done at the end of the 9th month of the 2nd year
- Resubmission of thesis with corrections can be done within stipulated period
- Resubmission of thesis with total redoing can be done within 2 years.

COLLEGE FEES

Each candidate selected for course should pay the prescribed fees on admission. Then at the beginning of each year should pay all the fees for the respective year.

STUDENT ACTIVITIES

Students are expected to participate in all the curricular, co - curricular and extra - curricular activities organized and conducted by the college and university. The undergraduate and Diploma Students should become the member of Student Nurses Association of the college.

HOSTEL

For all the B.Sc (Nursing), Post Basic B.Sc (Nursing) and Diploma in General Nursing and Midwifery students stay in the hostel is compulsory. Hostel facility is available for the M.Sc (Nursing) students however dayscholar are entertained. The rooms are spacious, well ventilated and provided with comfortable furniture. Our hostel is a Home away from Home. It is a superb blend of various cultures upholding the concept of unity in diversity. The hostel is provided with a Warden, Security Guards (24 Hours) to ensure safety. A recreation room is provided with Television and cable facility. Telephone facilities are also provided.

- Boarding and lodging will be provided in the hostel on the payment of prescribed charges.
- Vegetarian and Non vegetarian foods will be provided.
- Disciplinary action will be taken, if the candidate fails to adhere to the hostel rules and regulations.
- Students should not bring any valuables or jewellery. The college will not take responsible for loss or theft.

- No accommodation will be provided for male candidates.
- Use of mobile phones is strictly prohibited in the hostel and college campus.

UNIFORM

Students are required to wear the uniform prescribed by the college during clinical practice. Students have their hair put up and should wear only prescribed foot wear and also not allowed to wear jewellery except small ear rings during clinical experience. The uniform decorum should be strictly adhered by the staff and the students.

VACATION

Vacations are given according to the norms of Indian Nursing Council and The Tamilnadu Dr. M.G.R. Medical University. Disciplinary action will be taken if the student remain absent on the first and closing day of the term.







DISCIPLINE

- 1. Students are responsible to the principal for the behaviour both in and outside the college.
- 2. Students should maintain silence in the class, library and in the corridors when lectures are in session.
- 3. Students who are found to have major health problems will have to discontinue their course.
- 4. Students should not involve themselves in any religious activity publicly with in the campus during their tenure in the college.
- 5. Students should abide by the rules and regulations laid by the college, hostel and hospital authorities. Violation of rules will entail disciplinary action.
- 6. Students should not involve themselves in any anti social behaviour or cause any willful damage to the property of college, hostel and hospital. If found the student will be punished severely.

TRANSPORT

Buses and vans are available for the students to attend clinical postings at affiliated hospitals and community health centres.

ANTI RAGGING COMMITTEE

Ragging in any form, in any place or time is cognizable offence that will attract severe punishment including dismissal of the candidate from the institution.

A committee of staff members and student committee is constituted to guard the students against this offence.

WITHDRAWAL AND DISMISSAL

If any student decides to withdraw voluntary from the college after joining or before completing the course, shall be required to pay full fees for the entire course. The amount already paid by her will not be refunded.

However the management / principal of the college deserve the right to dismiss any student for their misconduct or misbehaviour during the period of study.

HEALTH CHECK UP

Each student will undergo an annual medical check up. If illness occurs during their course the student will be taken to near by hospital for the treatment. The hospitalization of the student for severe illness is also taken care with prior notification to the parents.

COUNSELING CELL

The college has functioning counseling cell for the faculty and students. The qualified counselor visits the cell once in a week and regular staff available for the counseling process. The resources are mobilized according to the needs of the institution.
